## GROW IN FAITH

## God Creates People—Genesis 1:26–2:4

In today's creation story things are not just good, they are supremely good! In this Bible story we hear God claiming how good they are through the process of creating. On the sixth day, God finally creates human beings in God's own image. Children might wonder if being created in the image of God means we look like God. And that could be. But you can also help the children look beyond physical appearance and think about how we each are a reflection of God. If God is the creator, then each of us has a piece of God's creativity. This means we get the important job of reflecting creativity and goodness to the world. Being human isn't always easy. But remember, God sees you as supremely good.

- Ask children what God might look like or how they are like God.
- Remind children that they are created by God.
- Share that God believes each of us is good.

## COME TOGETHER

## Prepare to Learn

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, Activity Sheets, Activity Stickers

**Prepare Ahead:** Set up your area with supplies and activity pages needed for today's session. Display the Unit 1 Bible Verse Poster (Class Pack—pp. 10 & 15), Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster (Class Pack—pp. 2 & 23), and Unit 1 Faith Response Poster (Class Pack—pp. 11 & 14) to use later in the session.

- As children arrive, invite them to join you in a circle.
- Give each child a copy of the "Fall Sticker Page" (Activity Sheets—p. 29) and their own set of Activity Stickers. Have children place the people sticker on the Session 2 space.

**SAY:** This month we will hear stories about creation. Today we are learning about how God created people!

**ASK:** What people are you grateful for? What do you love about how God created them?

#### Faith Focus—God Is Creative

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, crayons, scissors, glue, fabric, yarn, construction paper

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster (Class Pack—pp. 2 & 23). Photocopy "God Created Me!" (Leader Guide—p. 22) for each child.

• Show children the Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster.

**SAY:** Our faith focus for today is "God is creative." God was creative in creating people, and that includes you!

- Give each child a copy of "God Created Me!"
- Give children time to use the assorted materials to decorate the body outline to look like a self-portrait.

### **Good People**

Supplies: Activity Sheets, glue, scissors

Prepare Ahead: Tear out "Good People" (Session 2 Activity Sheet) for each child.

**SAY:** God made all people in the world. God was creative when making every person so they would all be different and still show God's goodness and love.

**SAY:** When God was creating everything that exists, including people, God called the creation "good."

**ASK:** How are you good?

 Help the children cut out the hearts on the page and glue one heart to each person in the picture. Invite the children to say the affirmation on the heart as they glue it to the picture.

ASK: What would you create? What do you want the world to look like?

## FAITH CONNECTIONS

### **Read the Story**

Supplies: CEB Bible storybook

• Invite the children to join you in a circle.

ASK: How do you think God created all the people in the world?

• Read the story of creation (Genesis 1:26–2:4) in a favorite CEB Bible storybook.

**ASK:** Why do you think God created people?

**SAY:** God called the people God created "good." When God looks at each of you, God calls you "good" too!

### **Big Faith Video**

Supplies: Big Faith DVD, TV, DVD player or streaming device

- Watch the Session 2 video on the Big Faith DVD or via your Amplify Media subscription.
- Share the questions on the screen with the children. You may also choose to add your own questions. Give children time to share their responses and ideas.

**SAY:** There are so many different kinds of people in the world. We have different skin colors and hair textures. We speak different languages and eat different foods and dress differently. We live in different places and celebrate different holidays. It is amazing that God was so creative to make all the people in the world.

ASK: How does it feel to know that God made each of us different and special?

## **Faith Response**

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, paper, colored pencils or thin markers, scissors, tape

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Unit 1 Faith Response Poster (Class Pack—pp. 11 & 14) and Unit 1 Bible Verse Poster (Class Pack—pp. 10 & 15) if you haven't already.

- Invite children to wonder about the images on the posters.
- Encourage children to say the Bible verse with you.

**SAY:** God used God's imagination to dream up the most beautiful way to make humans, with many colors of skin and hair and eyes and many sounds to express their feelings. All of us were made by God with great care and creativity.

• Lay the Faith Response Poster on the floor or a table and invite the children to gather around it.

**SAY:** When God was creating people, God was very gentle. The Bible story tells us that God held the dust of the ground in God's hands, and breathed the breath of life into the human. That means that God is breathing with us, and with all humans, whenever we are breathing!

- Instruct children to help one another each trace a handprint on a piece of paper. If desired, have them decorate or write their names on their handprints.
- Help children cut out their handprints and tape them in the next section of the Faith Response Poster.

**SAY:** God created you, (child's name), and you are good!

**Tip:** If not all the children's handprints fit on the poster, tape them surrounding the poster or in another place in your space.

## FUN WITH FAITH

## God's Beautiful People

**Supplies:** posterboard or large construction paper, scissors, markers, crayons, glue, beads, sequins, other craft materials as desired

**SAY:** Look at all these materials we have. These may look like just a pile of craft materials, but we can create something beautiful from them. When God was creating people, God took a handful of dust from the ground and breathed life into it. God made something beautiful from something that didn't look like very much to begin with.

**ASK:** How can you create something with these materials that reminds all people how beautiful they are?

- Divide the children into small groups. Give each group a piece of posterboard or large construction paper.
- Invite the children to use the materials to make a sign that says "You are beautiful" or another affirming statement. Help children write their statement and encourage them to use the materials to decorate the poster.
- Let willing volunteers share their creations.

**ASK:** How did you use your creativity?

## I Spy Something Beautiful

Supplies: a few small mirrors, posterboard or markerboard, markers

• Gather the children into a circle.

**ASK:** What do you see around you that is "very good"? What do you see that is beautiful? What do you see about each of us that is beautiful and good?

- Pass mirrors around the circle so each child gets a turn with one. As they look into a mirror, invite them to say, "I spy something beautiful ..." and then name what they see (me, my eyes, my smile, my hair, and so forth).
- As the children share, record what they say on posterboard or a markerboard.

**ASK:** What did you see in the mirror that was beautiful and good?

### SHARF YOUR FAITH

## Big Faith Idea—Faith in God

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Fall Big Faith Idea Poster (Class Pack—pp. 4 & 21). Make copies of the Unit 1 Family Faith Letter (Leader Guide—pp. 91–92) if needed.

• Show children the Big Faith Idea Poster.

**SAY:** When we appreciate God's creativity in making all people, we are praising God! And when we use our creativity to care for our neighbors and help make creation beautiful, we are praising God!

• Invite the children to gather in a circle. Invite them to pray with you with their hands outstretched to one another.

**PRAY:** Repeat after me: "Holy God, thank you for creating people and calling them good. Show me how to be creative as I care for your people and our world. Amen."

- Send the Unit 1 Family Faith Letter and activity home with each child who hasn't received them.
- Send home any activities or items made during today's session.



## GROW IN FAITH

## God Creates Us to Be Unique—Psalm 139:1-18

This passage of Scripture can provide us with comfort and peace as we better understand how we are created and loved by God. We are also made of God's love. These poetic words tell the inner workings of our human creation and God's intricate role in our lives from the very beginning. The psalm also states that God made us with purpose and we are wonderful. God is embedded in everything we do, and it is important to remember our value even when there are hard times or we are scared. This is a psalm children can carry with them to always remember God's word and God's love.

- Encourage children to name ways they are loved by God.
- Explore ways children can share God's love with others.
- Remind the children God is always with them.

## COME TOGETHER

#### **Prepare to Learn**

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, Activity Sheets, Activity Stickers

**Prepare Ahead:** Set up your area with supplies and activity pages needed for today's session. Display the Unit 1 Bible Verse Poster (Class Pack—pp. 10 & 15), Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster (Class Pack—pp. 2 & 23), and Unit 1 Faith Response Poster (Class Pack—pp. 11 & 14) to use later in the session.

- As children arrive, invite them to join you in a circle.
- Give each child a copy of the "Fall Sticker Page" (Activity Sheets—p. 29) and their own set of Activity Stickers. Have children place the heart sticker on the Session 3 space.

**SAY:** God created everything in the universe, and God created people. Today we explore how God created each of us to be unique.

ASK: What do you like about how God created you? What do you love about yourself?

#### Faith Focus—God Is Creative

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, crayons, scissors, glue

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster (Class Pack—pp. 2 & 23). Photocopy "Who I Am" (Leader Guide—p. 28) for each child.

• Show children the Unit 1 Faith Focus Poster.

**SAY:** Our faith focus for today is "God is creative."

**ASK:** How was God creative when making you unique?

• Invite the children to color the person to represent themselves, then cut out the images and glue them to the outline to represent who they are.

### **Unique Quilt Squares**

Supplies: Activity Sheets, pencils, crayons or markers, scissors

Prepare Ahead: Tear out "Unique Quilt Squares" (Session 3 Activity Sheet) for each child.

**SAY:** God created each of us to be unique. That means no one is exactly like anyone else. All of us have our own personalities, ideas, and hearts.

ASK: What is unique about you? What do you like about how God created you?

- Give each child a quilt square.
- Invite the children to draw or write something that they love about themselves in the center of the quilt square and then cut the square out.

## FAITH CONNECTIONS

## Read the Story

Supplies: CEB kids' Bible

- Invite the children to join you in a circle.
- Show children where the Book of Psalms is in the Bible.

**SAY:** Psalms is a book of the Bible that many people read to find comfort and to learn about God and themselves.

• Read Psalm 139:1-18.

**ASK:** What does the psalm say God knows about us? When and where is God with us? How does the psalm say God cares for us?

**Tip:** Today's passage may not be found in a children's storybook Bible. You may choose to show the Session 2 video before reading the passage in the Bible.

## **Big Faith Video**

Supplies: Big Faith DVD, TV, DVD player or streaming device

- Watch the Session 3 video on the Big Faith DVD or via your Amplify Media subscription.
- Share the questions on the screen with the children. You may also choose to add your own questions. Give children time to share their responses and ideas.

**ASK:** How are the people in the video uniquely created? Do any of the people in the video remind you of yourself and how you are unique?

### **Faith Response**

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack, star stickers

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Unit 1 Faith Response Poster (Class Pack—pp. 11 & 14) and Unit 1 Bible Verse Poster (Class Pack—pp. 10 & 15) if you haven't already.

- Invite children to wonder about the images on the posters.
- Encourage children to say the Bible verse with you.

**SAY:** When God was making everything, God was very creative! God used imagination to make all people, and to make each of us different.

ASK: What is a "masterpiece"?

**SAY:** If there is a work of art or music or creativity that is amazing, sometimes people say it is a "masterpiece." All of us are God's "masterpieces."

- Lay the Faith Response Poster on the floor or a table and invite the children to gather around it.
- Instruct children to each place a star sticker on the poster in the section for this session.
- As each child places a sticker, invite them to say, "I am God's masterpiece."

#### FUN WITH FAITH

## **Weaving Together**

Supplies: felt in at least two different colors, adult scissors, dowels or sticks, tape

Prepare Ahead: Cut felt into strips to measure about one inch by nine inches.

**SAY:** The Bible story today tells us that God knew how we were woven together or knitted together before we were born.

ASK: Do you know anyone who sews, weaves, knits, or crochets?

- Group the children into pairs. Give each child a dowel/stick and eight strips of felt, four in one color and four in another.
- Show children how to tape a narrow end of four strips of felt to the dowel or stick.
- Help the children weave the other four strips of felt through the four strips on the stick. Weave together in an "over, under, over, under" pattern.

ASK: How did it feel to weave something? Was it challenging? Did you enjoy it?

### **Group Quilt**

**Supplies:** butcher paper or wall space, tape, quilt squares made earlier, markers (optional)

**SAY:** Each of us made our own quilt square, and it was beautiful on its own. I wonder what it would look like if we all joined our squares to make one big quilt.

- Invite the children to hang the quilt squares up on a wall or tape them to a large piece of butcher paper to make a quilt out of all of them.
- You may wish to invite the children to decorate a special border that represents their class or group around the edges of their quilt.

**ASK:** Are any of the squares the same? How are they different?

**SAY:** When all of our quilt squares are joined together, it is even more beautiful!

## Your Special Name Room Sign

**Supplies:** plain art paper cut into four by eight rectangles, crayons, markers, permanent marker, scissors, hole punch, yarn, other assorted art supplies as available/desired

**SAY:** God made every person in the world. There is only one YOU, and that is amazing! Everything from your eyes to your laugh to your heart is one of a kind.

**ASK:** Do you know if there is a story behind your name? If there is, what is it?

- Give each child a paper rectangle and help them write their names on the paper.

  Use permanent marker to make the name stand out.
- Have children decorate their names using the art supplies.
- When they are finished, use a hole punch to make a hole on each end of the rectangle. Thread the yarn through the holes and then tie knots at the ends.

**ASK:** Where will you hang this sign with your name? What do you hope it shows people about you?

## SHARE YOUR FAITH

## Big Faith Idea—Faith in God

Supplies: All-Ages Class Pack

**Prepare Ahead:** Display the Fall Big Faith Idea Poster (Class Pack—pp. 4 & 21). Make copies of the Unit 1 Family Faith Letter (Leader Guide—pp. 91–92) if needed.

• Show children the Big Faith Idea Poster.

**SAY:** God created everything that exists, and that includes you! We can praise God because we are all uniquely made!

• Invite the children to gather in a circle with you. Invite them to pray with their eyes open and imitate your hand motions.

**PRAY:** Repeat after me and do the motions as I do them: "Holy God, thank you for making me unique (hands open with palms flat facing up). Help me love myself (hands over heart), help me love others (hands sweeping outwards from chest to sides), and help me love your beautiful creation (hands sweeping over head in an arch). Amen."

- Send the Unit 1 Family Faith Letter and activity home with each child who hasn't received them.
- Send home any activities or items made during today's session.
