Sermon: Am I Willing to Follow Jesus as My Lord?

Scripture: Matthew 22:34-40

Sermon Notes

Take time this week to dig deeper into the message with these questions:

1. What things do you put your hope in? What ideas, values, and beliefs shape your actions?
2. Read Matthew 22:34-40.
3. Do you believe the greatest commandment is true? Why or why not?
4. Someone once asked, "If you were put on trial for being a Christian would there be enough evidence to convict you?" Consider this for a moment.
5. In what areas of your life do you place Jesus as Lord and what areas is Christ not in the top spot?
6. What things might be different if Jesus was Lord of your life in every area – relationships, money, vocation, hobbies, etc.?
7. Jesus is worthy of our lives and living with Christ as our Lord is the greatest thing we can do in life. What is one action you can take today to entrust Jesus as your Lord and Savior?
8. Spend time in prayer.
