Sermon: Future Legacy

Scripture: Philippians 2:1-16

Sermon Notes

Take time this week to dig deeper into the message with these questions:

1. Think about good leaders you have know as well as figures from history. What are the marks of an effective leader?
2. Read Philippians 2:1-16.
3. In what ways did Jesus humble himself (vv.6-8)?
4. How is Jesus now exalted (vv.9-11)?
5. What is the connection between the two parts? Why should the Jesus who did what verses 6-8 say he did be honored in this way?
6. Compare the attitude of Christ in this passage with the typical attitude of worldly leaders.
7. Reread verses 12-16.
8. We are called to “carry out” or live out our salvation in the world. What are some characteristics we should have when living for Christ in the world?
9. When we live for Christ, we will “shine like stars in the world” (v. 15). Who has been a shining star in your life? How might you thank them for shining bright?
10. Who needs you to be a shining star for them? In what ways will you shine bright?
11. Spend time praying for each person this week.
