## Scripture: Luke 23:32-47

### Sermon Notes

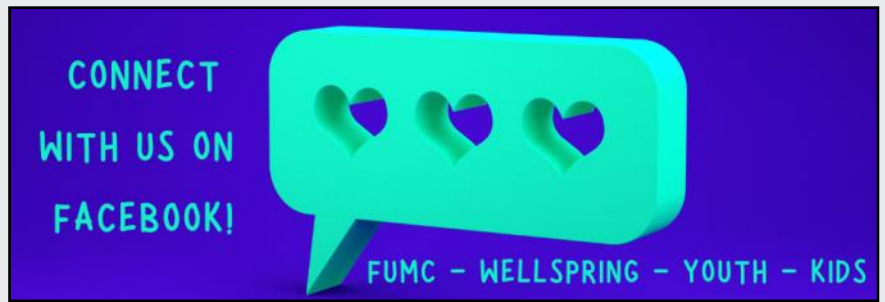
