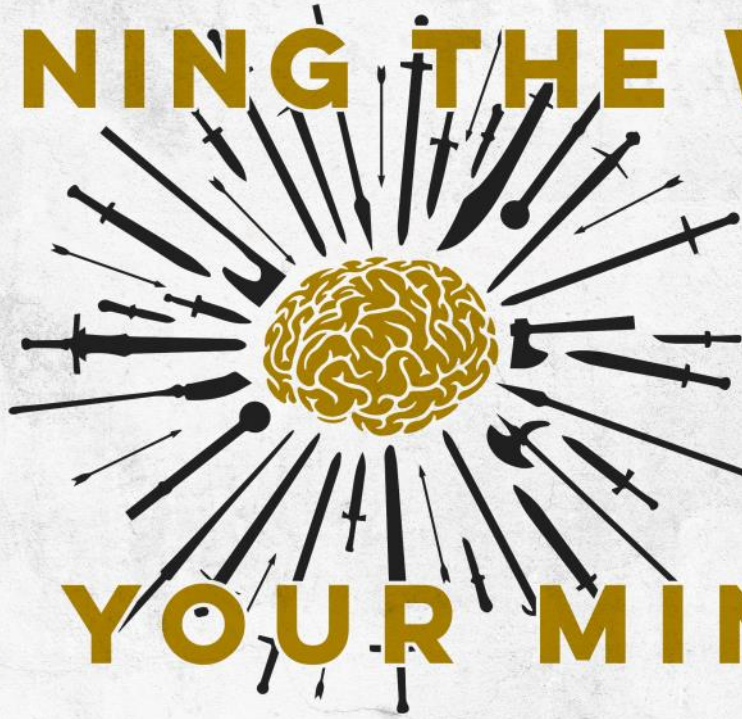

Sermon Notes

1. Did you have any worries as a kid that seem silly now? If so, what were they?
2. What caused those worries to go away?
3. What part of the sermon was most impactful for you and why?
4. Read Romans 12:1-2. What do you think it means to renew your mind?
5. What types of things might help renew your mind so you “can figure out what God’s will is – what is good and pleasing and mature?”
6. Read Philippians 4:6-9. How have you seen God at work in your life in the past?
7. What could you do to better focus your thoughts on God in the future?
8. In what ways are you thankful for Christ’s love and faithfulness?
9. Spend time in prayer giving thanks for God’s goodness in your life.
