Sermon Notes

Take time this week to dig deeper into the message with these questions:

1. Have you ever been asked to do a demeaning, lowly job? What thoughts went through your mind at the time?
2. In the bible, read John 13:1-17
3. According to John, what does Jesus know about himself (vv.1-3)? In light of that knowledge, what is remarkable about what Jesus does next (vv. 4-5)?
4. Foot washing was normally done by servants or slaves. Why do you think Jesus washed his disciples' feet instead of simply giving them a sermon on love?
5. After he finishes washing the disciples' feet, how does Jesus explain the significance of his actions (vv. 12-17)?
6. Among the people you live and work with, what would it mean to "practice footwashing" – to model the humble servant attitude of Jesus?
7. Spend time in prayer.
